Pastor Jess led us in a short study of "What Is the Church"?

The Church Is:

- 1) The temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor 3:6)
 - a. Where God presence resides, both individually and communally
 - b. The church is the unique, super-natural, living organism (not organization) of God presence on earth
- 2) The Body of Christ (1 Cor 12)
 - a. The church is the body and Christ is the head
 - b. We can not function/survive without our head. The head leads the body. The body belongs to Christ, the head
- 3) The Bride of Christ (Eph 5)
 - a. The church is those who Christ has died for, that He may sanctify her.
 - b. We look to Jesus, our husband, for our protection, provision and our "everything"
- 4) The posture of the church is "Come!" (see last paragraph of Revelation)

Then, all those in attendance offered their ideas on the following questions:

Where have we been? How has God been faithful to us in the past? / Where are we now? How is God leading us right now?
